## The Domus

The historic Domus is one of only two buildings remaining from the original 13th century Beaulieu abbey, which was previously one of the largest Cistercian monasteries in England.

The charming original features include exposed beams, stone walls and a large open fireplace creating a magnificent setting for up to 120 guests. Surrounding the Domus, is the spectacular cloisters, where exquisite drinks receptions are held.

The striking archways and beautiful stonework of the cloisters offer a perfect backdrop for those all-important photographs. Capture the whole wedding party with a group photo or the two of you can escape away to the Victorian Rose Garden, where you will find our wisteria tunnel, topiary, and fountains. 


