THE DOMUS

Grand and historic

The Domus is part of The Abbey which is central to the history of Beaulieu. Founded 800 years ago by Cistercian Monks from France, the Abbey was destroyed by Henry VIII during the Dissolution of the Monasteries. This left only two buildings intact: the lay brothers' dormitory, known as the Domus, and the Monks' Refectory, now the Parish Church of Beaulieu. The Domus can cater for up to 130 guests and offer the reception area of Cellarers Hall.

Its charming original features include exposed beams, stone walls and a large open fireplace creating a magnificent setting. Surrounding the Domus, the spectacular Cloister can be found, where exquisite drinks receptions are held within the striking archways and ruins creating the most atmospheric backdrop for your photographs. In addition to the Cloister, the wedding couple and their photographer may also have non-exclusive use of the beautiful Victorian Gardens, leading through a wisteria tunnel down towards the Beaulieu River, providing another sensational backdrop.



PALACE HOUSE

Intimate and romantic

Palace House, the Montagu family home since 1538 is set in immaculate grounds and gardens over-looking the Beaulieu River. The House provides a stunning setting for more intimate evening ceremonies and wedding receptions. Host your drinks reception in the grand and elegant entrance hall before heading through to the impressive lower dining room for a delicious wedding breakfast. The romance continues into the elegant lower drawing room which can be used for after dinner drinks.

The Lower Dining Hall will comfortably accommodate up to 36 guests around the long table and the Upper Drawing Room can accommodate 60 guests on banqueting round tables with an additional 30 evening guests. Palace House is available exclusively to you for your wedding after the visitor attraction closes. Closing times during summer are from 6pm and during winter from 5pm.
